WHAT IS UNIQUE ABOUT YOUR TRAINING?

I have furthered my education in the latest dental technology by completing programs at the Las Vegas Institute for Advanced Dental Studies. I have a passion for neuromuscular dentistry, which I have been doing for 22 years.

WHAT SHOULD PATIENTS EXPECT AT A CONSULTATION?

Attention. Creating a beautiful smile not only requires artistic design and the latest technology, but also my utmost attention. I schedule appointments to maximize each patient's time. No one sits in a waiting room. I devote attention to one patient at a time-allowing a block of even a few hours for a single client, if necessary.

HOW DO YOU REACH OUT TO PATIENTS?

I authored two books: Revitalize Your Smile and Revitalize Your Mouth. Both are informative guides that help patients decide on the best treatment to tackle crowded, crooked and poorly spaced teeth with bite function in mind.

Using neuromuscular dentistry in combination with cosmetic dentistry, Dr. Frey remakes smiles that are as beautiful as they are functional. "We can enhance the bite and create a new smile all in the same two visits it takes to do a traditional smile makeover with veneers," Dr. Frey says. Using computerized technology, Dr. Frey first identifies the optimized bite, or ideal shape and position of the bite, and then creates a trial smile that imitates the appropriate shape for the patient to test out. Finally, using customized porcelain veneers on the front and biting edges of teeth, Dr. Frey bonds a more even, ideally positioned set of teeth in place. "The process relieves jaw pain, neck pain, headaches and ear aches. When your bite is in alignment, you're going to look better and younger, but you're also going to feel better. Taking that tension off of your bite and the central nervous system goes beyond the smile, improving your posture and even flexibility," Dr. Frey says.





SMILE REVITALIZATION

After years of grinding, Hanna had lost one-third of the enamel on her teeth. By opening and changing her bite, Dr. Frey was able to restore her smile with porcelain veneers. "I liked the way he presented his material about getting the bite straight," Hanna says. "He promised that I probably wouldn't grind my difference.' Every time I walk by a mirror, I smile and look at my teeth. I feel that they look natural and absolutely beautiful. I would do it all over again."
